The Saint-Étienne Hors Cadre scheme is led by Saint-Étienne Tourisme & Congrès. This organisation is in charge of creating the momentum behind the scheme, facilitating synergies, coordinating initiatives, structuring the discovery packages and promoting it on the national and international tourism market.

Saint-Étienne's design, culture and creation network

Saint-Étienne Hors Cadre is also a multitude of stakeholders and contributors of all sizes, sometimes very small, which give the scheme its vitality and constitute the rich fabric of the destination. Their ambition is to help make it more visible and accessible, so that everyone can live their own customised Hors Cadre experience, where contact with real people is the heart of the matter.

Governance to increase synergies

Because everyone is convinced that raising the city and district as a tourist destination involves leveraging and orienting developments in a wide variety of areas (urban planning, the living environment, green spaces), a system of governance will be set up to provide a space for sharing ideas and taking the actions needed to efficiently reach the target set.

A town within a town, that was the idea harboured by Le Corbusier, the visionary architect who designed the Firminy site, just a stone's throw from Saint-Étienne. This site delights both connoisseurs and the curious: the multi-coloured Unité d'Habitation, a rather odd, cone-shaped church, a concave Maison de la Culture - a World Heritage site -, a stadium in the form of an amphitheatre and a swimming pool. You wanted Le Corbusier, well here it is, a place stuffed with anecdotes. Did you know that this site was his second largest complex in the world? And that the windows of the Maison de la Culture were musical windows? Guess which constellation appears in the concrete of Saint-Pierre's church? Head for the square, to find out and for a lesson in creativity!

Design gets the freedom of the Cité



As part of the "Cité Design 2025" project, in 2024 Saint-Étienne, the only French UNESCO Design City, is due to become the home of the first Galerie nationale du design, no less!

Musée d'Art et d'Industrie

Design is like riding a bike, once you've learnt, you never forget how!

Arms, ribbons and bikes. Put like that, it's hard to see the connection. And yet all it takes is a trip to the Musée d'Art et d'Industrie, whose unique collections will help you to understand why design is everywhere in Saint-Étienne. Saint-Étienne has always invented things. Firearms of course, but also weaving looms, textiles and bikes. It was actually here that the very first bicycle was invented. So head down in the handlebars, and three collections later, the links between Saint-Étienne's industrial past and its ambitions for the future will no longer hold any secrets for the visitor!

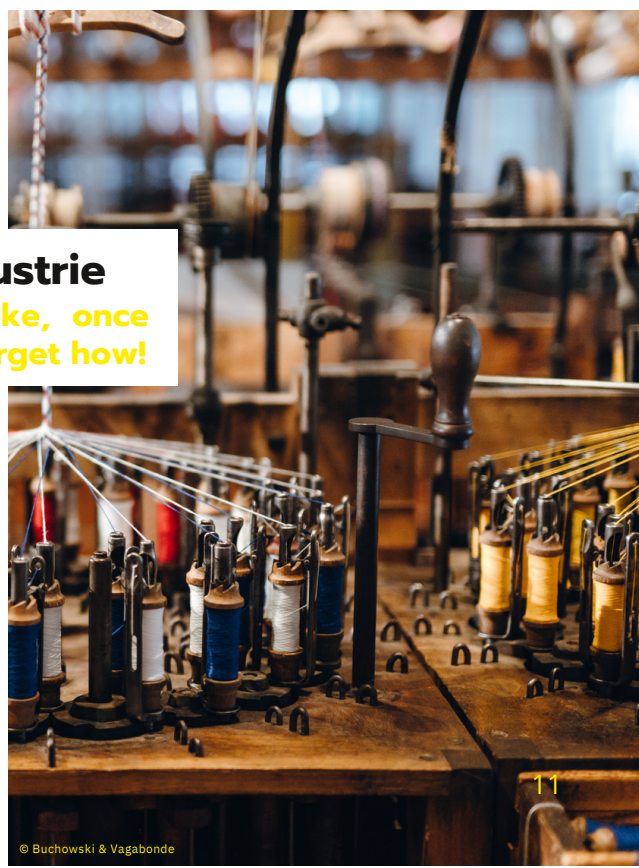

And to say they were making weapons here in the days of Louis XV. Two centuries and a few good ideas later, the Manufacture Royale has regenerated as the Cité du design and a Creative District. Horizontal, transparent and filled with light, La Platine certainly gets itself noticed: you can't deny that. This unusual box-like structure houses a library, a restaurant, an amphitheatre, a series of exhibition rooms and even a materials library. You can't imagine how many uses there are for translucent marble... All's well with the world. Outside, the Tour Observatoire can't help but show off - mind you, those 32 metres are enough to make you dizzy. No sign of a derelict industrial site now: the Manufacture quarter is now fairly buzzing with brainpower and hyperactivity.

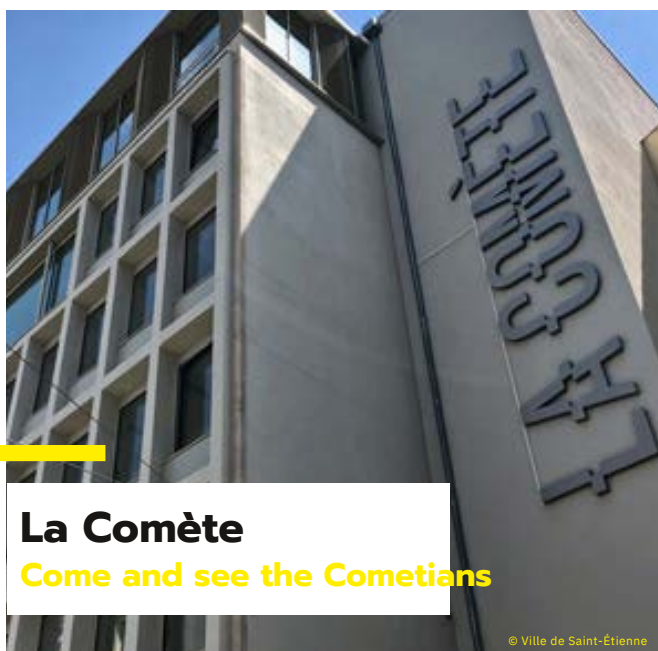
A fun château

If you think mining is something to do with big data, it is time to have a day out at the Puits Couriot. Before, it was here that miners went underground to dig coal. The site is now a listed Historic Monument and there's more fun to be had than in the old days. The museum tells the story of Saint-Étienne's adventure with coal. The museum pitches you right into the history of the mine with its display rooms and even offers a short trip underground. It's like being there for real, it shakes you up in every sense of the word. Outside, though, change of atmosphere: when summer comes, it's time to open the "ginguette". It gets off to a gentle start with a game of pétanque and a local beer, then everyone takes to a deckchair to watch the concerts and other entertainments. Just opposite, all this agitation does not stop the slag heaps from continuing to slowly consume themselves.

Come and see the Cometians

The Loire is France's longest river, 1006 kilometres – that's a lot of banks to build castles on... Well, of course you can't compare Bouthéon with Chambord or Chenonceau: smaller, further south, but also more unusual. In this former medieval fortress, ghosts show you around, paintings talk, looms still weave and fish swim in the basement. Also in the basement, you can board a ramberte (a barge created here 300 years ago to haul coal) along with a sailor who will tell all about river navigation and the Marine de la Loire. And all at no risk of getting wet - the experience is immersive, but digital! Outside, farm animals wander the paths, the gardens grow useful everyday plants and all the lakes in grounds are eco-friendly. Not bad eh, life at the château?

La Comète is the latest addition to Saint-Étienne' range of cultural venues. Once again, this is the story of a conversion typical of Saint-Étienne, that of the old La Comédie (now in the creative district), which has been turned into a creative centre for performers and an incubator of live performances. Five tenants share La Comète (we call them the Cometians) and, as in any house share, there are plenty of people coming and going and mingling. Everyone's welcome in the entirely renovated building: come for a jazz evening, to take part in a theatre discovery workshop, to have a music lesson, to rehearse in one of the studios, or to see any of the shows that are on throughout the year. Without building comets in the sky (OK, mixing metaphors there...), we are sure that this new centre for artistic exploration has great days ahead of it!

Even if you don't like football, you will have heard of Saint-Étienne's mythical football club. Everybody knows the ASSE. After all, it is the club with the most French championship titles to its name... ten in all - even PSG hasn't achieved that (yet). The Greens even had their own museum before everyone else. In short, the Cauldron, Aimé Jacquet, Platini ... we all know them. But the ASSE is like the city of Saint-Étienne: out of the ordinary, creative and innovative. And not everybody knows that. A logo designed back in the 60s by a Fine Arts student, an interplanetary hit pop song sung by a former player - "Je te survivrai, d'un amour vivant..." - a 360° immersion headset to relive a game as if you were there, 2,600 sqm of solar panels on the stadium roof... So, as the chant goes, "Who's the best? The Greens, of course".

Before and after the Loire Gorges



The Loire, deciduous forests, castles, islands, steep cliffs.

Guess where you are. In the Loire Gorges Nature Reserve, well done! 4,000 hectares of pure nature, 355 of which are in the Regional Nature Park – fresh air in abundance. And it isn't just oaks that have popped up along the river banks – there are castles too. Essalois stands proud up on its rock, but actually it's a cool one to visit. It's open to the public, for free. On the other side, there's Grangent. All alone on its island, it's hard to imagine it used to be perched at a height of 60 metres... Before the dam was built, the valley looked quite different. At Saint-Victor, they lost a railway line, but gained a water sports centre. And with it a beach, a marina, boat trips and some fantastic angling, all within throwing distance of the city centre... National newspaper Le Monde has got the measure of it - it has placed our Gorges among the 20 sites in the world to visit in 2023, no less!

Le Pilat: nothing to do with the dune of the same name.



Our Le Pilat is 700 sq km of mountain and forest, a radical change of scenery just 10 minutes from Saint-Étienne city centre. The highest peak in the Regional Nature Park reaches an altitude of only 1,400 metres. Nothing too dizzying, so there's no excuse for not getting just a bit sporty. Whether by bike or in your trainers or on Shanks' pony, come and enjoy a ramble among the old stones of the medieval castle of Rochetaillée. At the Gouffre d'Enfer (the Abyss of Hell), one of the many dams in the area, you can join the locals on their favourite walk. But don't worry, there's nothing hellish about it, on the contrary it's a real paradise for Sunday outings!

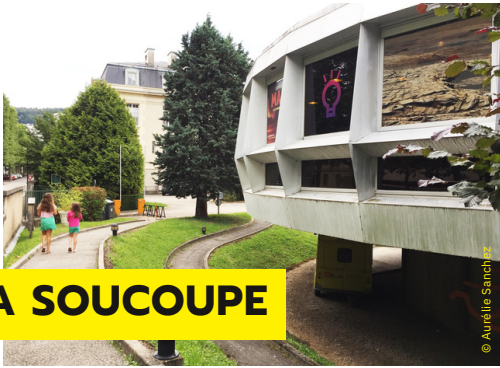
THE ARTY HIGHLIGHT



GALERIE CEYSSON & BÉNÉTIÈRE

In Saint-Étienne we have one of France's largest art galleries! Founded in Saint-Étienne by François Ceysson and Loïc Bénétière in 2006, the Ceysson & Bénétière gallery now has branches in Luxembourg, Paris, Geneva, New York and, most recently, Lyon. Galerie Ceysson & Bénétière represents national and international artists, and in particular members of the Supports/Surfaces MOVEMENT.

THE CREATIVE HIGHLIGHT



LA SOUCOUPÉ

Here, it's all about curiosity: asking questions, searching, testing, discovering, exchanging, marvelling and having fun. Here experiments are conducted by La Rotonde, the cultural, scientific, technical and industrial centre at the École des Mines engineering school in Saint-Étienne.

THE MUSICAL HIGHLIGHT



LE ZÉNITH

This modern Saint-Étienne monument was designed by Sir Norman Foster. Doesn't the name ring a bell? He's a British architect, a genius known the world over. His projects include the Millau viaduct, London's City Hall, Hong Kong airport. But here what you can admire is the concert hall's astonishing roof, shaped to capture the flow of the winds coming in from the valley, to ventilate and cool the inside of the building. There's never a dull moment at Saint-Étienne Zénith: from rock to comedians to reggae to sports events, there really is something for every taste.

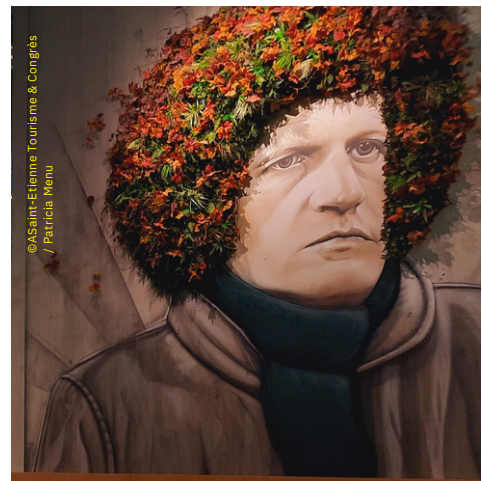
THE HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHT



DAPHNÉ CHANGED INTO LAURELS

"Daphné changed into laurels" is a sculpture by Jules Dercheu (1864-1912). In 1942 Daphné suffered the fate of many a bronze statue in our city - she was removed and then disappeared without trace. It's likely she was melted down in Germany. It took until 2022 for a copy to be made and become the centrepiece of the fountains on Place Jean Jaurès.

THE DESIGN HIGHLIGHT



GEOFFROY-GUICHARD STADIUM BRASSERIE

Inside it's not a decoration that you can see, it's an entire tribute to Roger Rocher (former club chairman) and Robert Herbin (former player and coach). And to continue the theme, the bar is a reproduction in miniature of the stadium's first stand.

The Dd4 is a special place adjoining the Halles Mazerat-Biltoki which serves a generous cuisine and good beer, with something for every taste. This is no run-of-the-mill restaurant or bar - it's a café where culture meets conviviality, just the way we like it round here!

With a name like that, you'll have guessed that this time we are venturing beyond Saint-Étienne itself. The Grand Tour is an invitation to step over the city line and explore some of the highways and byways around Saint-Étienne that are really worth the effort! It's just 15 kilometres from the city to the second largest Le Corbusier masterpiece in the world: the Firminy site. You could almost walk there, but we need to save some time and energy for the Gier valley, the Loire gorges, and the Château de Bouthéon.

Outing

Long and winding roads

Have you ever seen a village that moved into an old Carthusian monastery? No? Well, that's normal enough, but we have one: **Sainte-Croix-en-Jarez**, a Loire **Village de Caractère** and listed as one of the **most beautiful villages in France**, which boasts a truly unique historic and natural heritage. In the Jarez area, you will need to climb up high to see this unusual site. We are a long way from monastic austerity, though. Here, they welcome the inquisitive of all ilks, for creative visits with a variety of activities and events. The year is punctuated by a whole series of festivals, exhibitions, orienteering courses, games, etc. If your thing is walks and big rocks, we've got just what you need too: a great one-hour walk out to the Roches de Marlin megalithic site. But the Jarez region also has another trick up its sleeve over in La Terrasse-sur-Dorlay. The town is home to one of the most unusual museums in Loire: the **Maison des Tresses et Lacets**. This magical place is taking care to preserve the know-how of a whole region, whose braiding machines made a huge contribution to fashion until the middle of the 20th century. So tie your laces and set off for the Jarez, a region full of surprises!

Outing

Novaciéries turns a

Would you like to know what the future looks like? Well, it's at Saint-Chamond that it's happening! The most telling example is the **Novaciéries neighbourhood**. This derelict industrial site has certainly changed, you can see that. Converted into an immense leisure area, with its brand new Véo Grand Lumière cinema, its restaurants, its shops and skatepark, the great hall has become the new favourite icon of the Couramiaux ("chasers of cats") – that's another name for Saint-Chamond's inhabitants, which came about because it was said that they spent their time chasing after cats. But in Saint-Cham', you can also find some impressive architectural symbols. You can visit the old Hôtel-Dieu, the churches of Saint-Pierre, Saint-Ennemond and Notre Dame or the Hôtel de Ville and its inner courtyard overlooking Nelson Mandela park. The town dear to Antoine Pinay and Alain Prost is constantly changing. Be warned, in Saint-Chamond, they live life to the full. And if want to take a souvenir of your stay home, we suggest you pop into the **brand new Saint-Étienne Hors Cadre store in Saint-Chamond** - like its big brother in the city it has all the local goods you need!

Believe it or not, Saint-Étienne has its very own **fine sandy beach**, over by the picturesque village of **Saint-Victor-sur-Loire**. Ideal for a dose of farniente on the beach at the water's edge or to take a cruise on the river. And to admire the treasures of the Loire Gorges nature reserve, which this year features in the lists of sights to see published by newspaper Le Monde. You will also be able to climb up to the medieval village of Saint-Victor with its **breath-taking views over the Loire**. A chance to take a trip back in time by visiting the castle and the church. Once you come back down again, you can head back towards Saint-Étienne, stopping off for a stroll through the Le Berland rose garden. From Les Condamines, a little bit further along, the **hiking trails** begin, lots of them. They lead you into the secrets of the nature reserve, a magical experience.

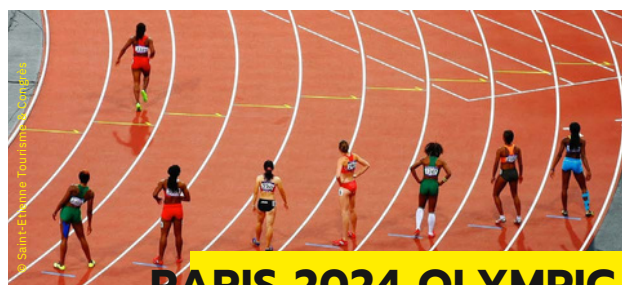


RUGBY WORLD CUP 2023
